Foundation 100 Days

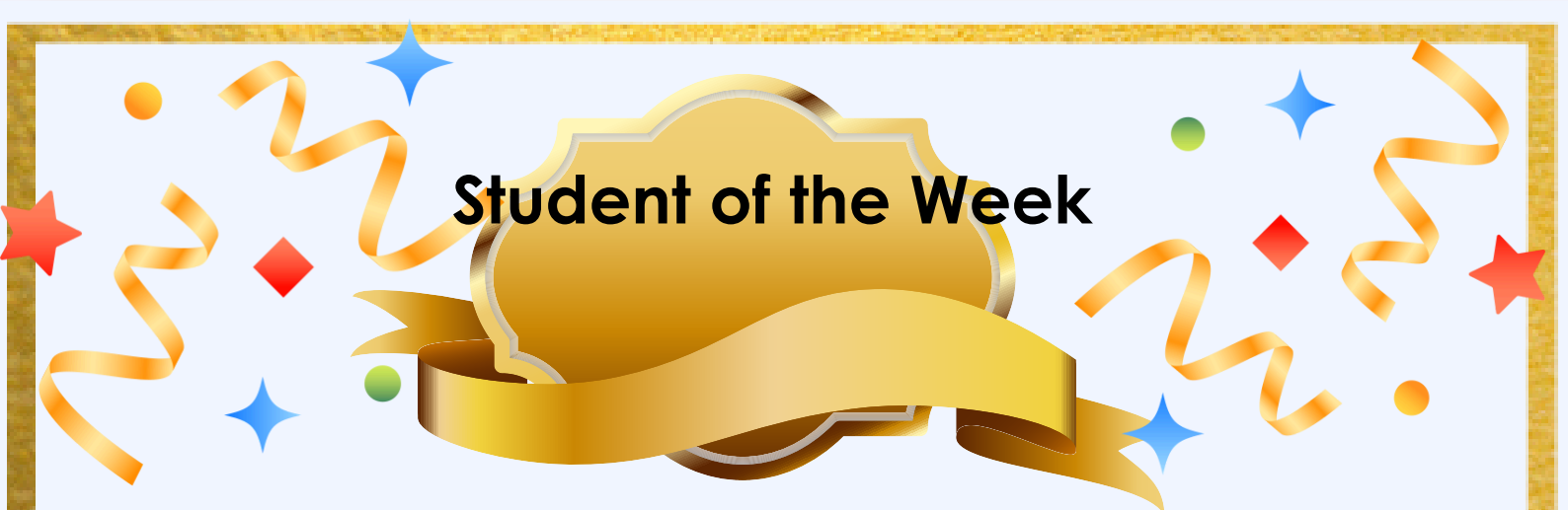
